Millions chant Sri Hanuman Chalisa daily to fulfill their desires or to overcome their fears or ward off diseases and adversities. This chanting is made even more powerful when it is performed in a group (Samasthi-Parayan)

THE HANUMAN CHALISA Says

जो सत बार पाठ कर कोई। छूटहि बन्दि महासुख होई॥

Whoever chants Sri Hanuman Chalisa even 7 times, is freed from bondage and attains great happiness.

जो दायकु फल चारि।

It also says that chanting it, helps one to attain all the four pursuits of human life: **Dharma** (Righteousness), **Artha** (Prosperity), **Kama** (Happiness) and **Moksha** (Freedom)

The benefit of group chanting is multiplied. Each individual is blessed with the punya (merits) accrued by the entire group's chanting. Imagine the power of thousands of people chanting Sri Hanuman Chalisa 21 times!

When a group of people come together and invoke Bhagawan, through a **havan** (fire-ritual), ahutis (offerings) and powerful vibrations are sent through the universe, the Yajaman's selfless devotion and dedicated actions will bless him/her and everyone else with great purity of mind and merits.

1. Chinmaya Organisation for Rural Development (CORD)



CORD has been serving in about 750 villages in Himachal Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Sri Lanka and is beginning its seva in Maharashtra. Chinmaya Mission Mumbai is actively supporting CORD at Gagode Village in Raigad District in the areas of education, micro-finance, health and community empowerment by helping the villagers to be self reliant in terms of livelihood.



2. Seva Projects of Chinmaya Mission Mumbai

For Medical Outreach

Medical diagnostic camps which include blood tests, ECG, ophthalmic, optometric, dental checkups and physician consultations based on the results.

Financial support for children undergoing cardiac surgery, neuro surgery and cancer treatment

For Differently Abled Children

Spastic, visually and hearing impaired children are provided with aids as required. Wheelchairs, splints, hearing aids, financial support for surgeries, dental checkups & treatments & special meals are provided.



• For Destitute Women

Financial aid, medical checkup, support from trained psychologists, food hampers are given to them.

• For the Elderly

Medical diagnostic seva, providing mandatory medicines and daily requirements, interactions & special meals are provided to the elderly.





3. Chinmaya Vishwa Vidyapeeth (CVV)

- Chinmaya Vishwa Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University, was established in 2016, with a core mission to blend the time-tested wisdom of Bharat with present-day knowledge fields. With campuses in Kerala and Maharashtra, Chinmaya Vishwa Vidyapeeth (CVV) offers a vibrant student life through holistic development, guided by its core values such as purity, spirituality, practicality and innovation.
- Chinmaya Vishwa Vidyapeeth (CVV) also provides scholarships to deserving meritorious students who want to pursue various academic programmes at the university. Infrastructure is still being built in phases through donations and CSR contributions.

4. Establishment of a new Chinmaya Mission Center in South Mumbai (Navy Nagar to Prabhadevi)

- A dedicated space of around 2,000 sq. ft or more.
- Will include a satsang hall and classrooms to cover activities like Shishuvihar, Balavihar, Yuva Kendra, Study Groups, office space and other spiritual and cultural activities.



5. Punahpratishtha of Shree Mahalakshmi Devi

- Mahalakshmi Mandir at Chinmaya Prerana, Kharghar has been serving devotees since 2009. Thousands visit the mandir, especially on festive occasions like Navaratri.
- After more than 15 years, the transfer of Kala from the existing murti to a new murti of Sri Mahalakshmi Devi will be held in January 2026 & the Punahpratishtha will take place in March 2026.

6. Chinmaya Gita Chanting Competition

• An annual initiative where more than 10,000 children participate free every year.

Chinmaya Mission was established by the devotees of the world-renowned Vedanta teacher Pujya Gurudev Swami Chinmayananda. Guided by His vision, devotees all around the world formed the nucleus of a spiritual renaissance movement that now encompasses a wide range of spiritual, educational, and charitable activities, ennobling the lives of people in India and across its borders.
